

IMPLEMENTATION OF A STRUCTURAL TAX
COMPLIANCE RELIEF PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUAL TAX
PAYERS AND BUSSINESSES TO MITIGATE COVID 19
IMPACTS IN JIGAWA STATE.

His Excellency is aware that the Covid 19 pandemic and the related lockdown has resulted in major negative economic impact as most businesses suffered a liquidity crisis during this period and required short term relief to get them back on stream. The *TAX INCENTIVES / RELIEF recommended* by the Board are as follows;

1. The Jigawa State Government should consider the approval of giving TAX HOLIDAY for 18 months with the effect from 1st July, 2020 up to December 2021 to all New Enterprises (Business name only) and individual businesses that will come up after Covid-19 pandemic in the State.
2. Government should extend the incentives to existing small and medium enterprises (Business name only) who suffered as a result of covid-19 by given them 1-year tax holiday with effect from 1st July, 2020 up till 31st December, 2021.

3. All existing enterprises (Business name only) and individual taxpayers in the State should have an extension date of filing the returns up till 30th September, 2020.
4. Government should consider the reduction of penalty and interest to one (1) single digit number i.e from 10% to 5% on penalty and from 21% to 9% on interest respectively for late filing of annual returns by individual taxpayers and enterprises.
5. The Government should consider and approve the 50% waiver on business premises license.
6. The Government should consider given 50% waiver on informal sector taxpayers preferably (presumptive taxpayers) as contained under 5th schedule, section 57(1) of Jigawa State Revenue (Codification and consolidation) law No. 4 of 2019. with effect from 1st July, 2020 up till 31st December, 2021.
7. Already the Government has approved 50% waiver for ware house rent for businesses at the EPZ, based on memo submitted by the Ministry of Commerce.
8. These incentives do not affect corporate bodies who are required to file their returns in respect of their employees on or before 31st January of each year.

Against this background, His Excellency is kindly invited to NOTE

- That the above recommendations are part of the conditions and requirements of the Disbursement Link Indicator II. (DLI2) to States for compliance under State Fiscal Transparency and Sustainability Programme (SFTAS) financing programme.
- That tax compliance relief program approved by the State should be published online on State government websites and National dailies.

- A press release should be made by the Honorable Commissioner for Finance and Economic Planning on the tax relief program.
- That 14th July, 2020 is the deadline for the submission of evidence(s) to DLI2 in respect of the aforementioned guide lines.

In the light of the above, His Excellency is graciously requested to;

- I. APPROVE number 1 to 8 recommendations for tax compliance/relief program for individual tax payers and businesses to mitigate covid 19 impacts in Jigawa State
- II. APPROVE the Tax compliance relief program to be published online on State government websites and at least two National dailies by the Jigawa State Board of Internal Revenue.
- III. APPROVE press release to be made by the Honorable Commissioner for Finance and Economic Planning on the tax relief program on behalf of the State Government. OR
- IV. DIRECT most appropriately

EXECUTIVE APPROVAL OF TAX RELIEF TO MITIGATE COVID-19 IMPACT

Sequel to the submission for the Structural Tax Relief by the State Internal Revenue source and in line with the provision of Part III Section 10(3) of Law No. 4 of 2019, I am to convey the executive governor's approval of the following Tax Relief to Businesses in Jigawa State:

1. A tax holiday for 18 months with the effect from 1st July, 2020 up to December, 2021 to all new enterprises (Business name only) and individual businesses that will come up after corona virus 19 pandemic in the State;

4. Reduction of penalty and interest to one single digit number i.e. from 10% to 5% on penalty and from 21% to 9% on interest respectively, for late filing of annual returns individual taxpayers and enterprises.
5. A 50% waiver on business premises license.
6. A 50% waiver on informal sector (presumptive taxpayers) from 1st July, 2020 up till 31st December, 2020 as contained under 5th schedule, section 57(1) of Jigawa State Revenue (codification and consolidation) law no.4 of 2019 with effect from 1st July, 2020 up till 31st December, 2021.


